The Leadership Tulsa flagship program helps individuals build their personal, professional and community leadership skills. Through a ten-month series of monthly meetings and a unique board internship experience, participants learn more about the history of Tulsa, become familiar with the challenges facing our city, and develop a network to make a difference. Individuals applying for this program have gained success in personal or professional settings and desire the opportunity to become more informed, connected and engaged in the larger Tulsa community.

Deadlines in April and October

Program Cost: \$2800 (scholarships available)



Thrive is a 10-month training and networking opportunity for people who seek to learn and collaborate with others to make positive change in Tulsa. Participants will meet twice monthly with their cohort to learn core skills for mobilizing people to make progress on complex community challenges. Participants will develop ideas and explore collaborations for community impact projects that they will launch no later than the beginning of the fall of 2018. Participants will create a plan for their own development as a leader.

Thrive is open to those who work, live, or want to contribute to positive change in Tulsa.

Deadline in October

Program Cost: \$500 (scholarships available)



In partnership with the Greater Tulsa Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, The Hispanic Leadership Institute (HLI) promotes the individual development of Tulsa-area Hispanics generally between the ages of 21 and 45 who have exemplified leadership qualities in their professional environment for increased participation in leadership roles. HLI allows individuals to develop and expand their knowledge, leadership skills and connections to take an active role in the community. HLI also offers participants the opportunity to engage with Tulsa's foremost business and policy authorities in a continuing dialogue about leadership and the civic sector. Ideal candidates are willing to learn and will be encouraged to give back to the Tulsa region through community involvement.

Program Cost: \$750 (scholarships available)

CHANGEMAKERS**

New under the Leadership Tulsa umbrella is the program Tulsa Changemakers. This program has a mission to empower promising youth leaders to drive positive impact in Tulsa right now and into the future. Founded by Teach for America corps members Andrew Spector and Jake Lerner, this 32-session after-school program will target middle and high school students in best-practice learning around youth driven impact. Students in 17/18 will primarily come from the Hale and McLain feeder patterns.

in partnership with Tulsa Area United Way

In partnership with the Tulsa Area United Way, the New Voices Board Internship program is designed to increase diversity on Tulsa area boards. The year-long program includes a full day training in August and six bi-monthly sessions with board mentors. Candidates will be from diverse racial, ethnic or religious backgrounds who have commitment to serve the nonprofit sector in a leadership role, but have not previously served on more than one nonprofit board of directors.

Seeking to prepare the next generation of community leaders through a strategic partnership with the Chamber's Tulsa's Young Professionals, this program offers young professionals opportunities to receive board training and serve as board interns. Individuals interested apply to and are selected by the TYPros organization. Leadership Tulsa provides the board training and agency engagement.
